## Why drop n shop?

- 1** Drop n Shop at Jumbos Playland is a safe and secure place to leave your children for up to 3 hours. The kids have fun and can get you some much needed "me time".
- 2** It is a the perfect solution for those times when you really need someone to watch your kids, or you just need a break to run errands, visit the hairdressers or meet friends for lunch.
- 3** The kids love coming to Jumbos and you can relax knowing they are well looked after and having a great time!
- 4** Come and meet our wonderful staff and find out why you will have peace of mind leaving them with us!

This service is available to children

- who are toilet trained and capable of letting the carer know they 'need to go'.

It includes

- all the usual play at Jumbos
- structured activities such as craft, playdough fun & story-telling
- lunch & drinks; and
- unlimited play when the parent/caregiver returns.

Parents will be required to show their drivers licence (we will photocopy it). The same person who drops off their child MUST be the person that picks up their child. An automatic \$25 late fee will apply if your child is not collected WITHIN the 3 hour period (we will take a deposit from parents for this purpose and it will be returned when children are collected)

# Drop n Shop FAQ'S

## What age is accepted for the Drop n Shop?

Jumbos accepts children aged between 2 and 10 years old. This service is available to children who are toilet trained and are capable of letting the carer know they 'need to go'.

## How are the children supervised?

The children are fully supervised the entire time that they are under our care. We have strict policies in place to ensure your child remains on our premises and is accounted for at all times. The ratio of carers to children is 1:8

## What do the children do whilst at Jumbos' Drop n Shop?

We will begin with an age appropriate environment that will encourage children to learn, play and explore. Books and blocks, craft and crayons, toys and tambourines. Our structured activities will consist of music, dance, craft, playdough, storytelling as well as free play exploring Jumbos' equipment.

## How long can I leave my children for Drop n Shop?

Drop n Shop starts at 10am every Wed & Thursday and finishes at 1pm. You MUST drop your children off and pick them up within this 3 hour period.

## What happens if my child becomes unsettled in my absence?

If your child or children become unsettled, we will do our best to reassure and correct the situation. However, if they continue to feel unsettled then we will call in the parent to collect their child. No refunds will be issued.

## What happens if my child is injured under Jumbos' care?

If a minor injury occurs we will ring you immediately to notify you of the circumstances. If a major injury occurs we will call an ambulance, followed by a phone call to the parent. All Jumbos' carers are trained in First Aid.

## What happens if my child gets hungry?

Jumbos provides lunch and drinks for all children in this program. You can view upcoming menus at the reception.

## My child has allergies to certain foods.

We will discuss your child/children's needs when you enrol for Drop n Shop. The enrolment form is quite specific to ensure your child/children receive the proper care.

## What do I need to bring for my child?

Socks and a spare set of clothes.
